Visiting the Killing Fields and Toul Sleng Genocide Museum

The Killing Fields memorial and Toul Sleng Genocide Museum tell the tragic story of Cambodia's history. It is a heart-breaking experience, and yet, we believe, an important one for all MishCammers in order to understand how the situation came to be for Cambodia and why the country is in need of our support.

Local Market Shopping

In Soksan Village

Teaching

Soksan International School uses a Project-Based Learning model of education, which means that our students are always working on a huge variety projects that appeal to their own interests, this means there's always something that matches the skills of our MishCammers. We'll pair you up with some students that are working on projects in your area of expertise so you can be their mentor for a few weeks.

Fishing

Cambodian Fishing is an experience! Be prepared to get muddy and wet as you head to the local dam for some net-fishing. Whatever you bring back is lunch, so make sure you catch plenty!

Cooking

SIS has a team of local ladies that cook every day for our staff and many of our students, and they love it when our MishCammers come to help out. You'll head to the local market to pick out the best produce and ingredients, then spend the morning cooking up a storm. They'll teach you all their tricks and recipes (except for Soksans Sauce, that stuff is top secret).

Sambor Prei Kuk Temples

Did you know that Kampong Thom Province is home to Sambor Prei Kuk, an ancient temple complex that pre-dates Angkor Wat by hundreds of years? We'll visit these incredible temples lost to time, and get shown around by our students who will tell you all about the history and significance of the landmark.

Bike Riding

The best way to explore the countryside around Soksans Village is on wheels and we'll hit the tracks on some mountain bikes with a team of students. Depending on interest and ability we can go for a cruisey short ride, or if you're feeling a little more extreme maybe something longer and more technical.

Angkor Wat
