The Mission: Cambodia volunteer trips are a set price,

they include all food, accommodation, itinerary activities etc. They do not include flights or visas to and from Cambodia, however we are happy to help you arrange and book these.

The cost of Mission: Cambodia is \$3000 AUD per person.

\$1500 of this cost is tax deductible to Australian tax payers. We encourage our volunteers to fundraise this \$1500 by holding BBQ lunches, bake stalls, raffles etc, among family and friends and in their community, this money goes towards the service projects the group will work on in Cambodia, and therefore can be claimed as a donation to the foundation.

All volunteers who are over the age of 18 must submit a valid Working With Children's Check and/or a valid Police Check to the foundation prior to the trip, any volunteers who fail to submit such documents will not be permitted to attend.

The foundation tailor makes every volunteer groups itinerary and can cater for younger people. Normally our age limit for traveling without a parent is 15, however we encourage families to bring their whole family along and can easily adjust to suit children of all ages.
